- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 502.001, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subdivision (44-a) to read as follows:
- 7 (44-a) "Utility vehicle" has the meaning assigned by
- 8 Section 663.001.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 502.140, Transportation Code, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 502.140. CERTAIN OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES. (a) Except as
- 12 <u>otherwise</u> provided by Subsection (b), a person may not register an
- 13 all-terrain vehicle, [er] a recreational off-highway vehicle, or a
- 14 <u>utility vehicle</u>, with or without design alterations, for operation
- 15 on a public highway.
- 16 (b) The state, a county, or a municipality may register an
- 17 all-terrain vehicle, [er] a recreational off-highway vehicle, or a
- 18 <u>utility vehicle</u> that is owned by the state, county, or municipality
- 19 for operation on a public beach or highway to maintain public safety
- 20 and welfare.
- 21 (c) [(d)] Section 504.401 does not apply to an all-terrain
- 22 vehicle, [or a recreational off-highway vehicle, or a utility
- 23 vehicle.
- 24 [(e) An all-terrain vehicle or recreational off-highway

- 1 vehicle that is owned by the state, a county, or a municipality and
- 2 operated in compliance with Section 663.037 does not require
- 3 registration under Subsection (b).
- 4 SECTION 3. The heading to Section 663.037, Transportation
- 5 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 663.037. OPERATION ON PUBLIC ROADWAY [PROHIBITED].
- 7 SECTION 4. Sections 663.037(a) and (f), Transportation
- 8 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 9 (a) A person may [not] operate an off-highway vehicle on a
- 10 public street, road, or highway only [except] as provided by this
- 11 section and Section 663.0372.
- 12 (f) This [Except as provided by Subsection (g), this]
- 13 section does not apply to the operation of an off-highway vehicle
- 14 that is registered under Section 502.140(b) [owned by the state, a
- 15 county, or a municipality by a person who is an authorized operator
- 16 of the vehicle].
- 17 SECTION 5. Subchapter C, Chapter 663, Transportation Code,
- 18 is amended by adding Section 663.0372 to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 663.0372. OPERATION ON PUBLIC ROADWAY IN CERTAIN
- 20 COUNTIES. (a) In addition to operation authorized by Sections
- 21 663.037 and 502.140(b), an off-highway vehicle may be operated on a
- 22 public street, road, or highway in a county with a population of
- 23 less than 150,000 in a manner authorized in that location for the
- 24 operation of a neighborhood electric vehicle.
- 25 (b) If the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles adopts rules
- 26 relating to the registration of and issuance of license plates for
- 27 neighborhood electric vehicles under Section 551.302, the

- 1 department must adopt corresponding rules for off-highway vehicles
- 2 operating under this section.
- 3 SECTION 6. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 4 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 5 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 6 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 7 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 8 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 9 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 10 before that date.
- 11 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
