A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to state recognition of the Mount Tabor Indian Community.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. The state of Texas recognizes the Associate
- 5 Bands of the Mount Tabor Indian Community and its members as
- 6 American Indians. Neither the tribe nor its members are eligible
- 7 for any services, funding, or any lands to be held in trust by the
- 8 State of Texas. The Associate Bands of the Mount Tabor Indian
- 9 Community shall maintain a membership roll, governing documents
- 10 and, a governing body. The Associate Bands of the Mount Tabor
- 11 Indian Community are not hereby prohibited from seeking federal
- 12 acknowledgment through the Department of the Interior, Bureau of
- 13 Indian Affairs, Office of Federal Acknowledgment, or any other
- 14 means as set forth under United States law. Eminent domain may not
- 15 be used by the tribe, nor may eminent domain be used to acquire
- 16 lands for the tribe. This bill in no way effects the hunting,
- 17 fishing, trapping, gathering or acquisition of other natural
- 18 resources of its members as citizens of Texas.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
