A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the collection of certain judgments through court
3 proceeding.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 31.002(a), Civil Practice and Remedies
6 Code, is amended to read as follows:

7 (a) A judgment creditor is entitled to aid from a court of
8 appropriate jurisdiction, including a justice court, through
9 injunction or other means in order to reach property to obtain
10 satisfaction on the judgment if the judgment debtor owns property,
11 including present or future rights to property, that is not exempt
12 from attachment, execution, or seizure for the satisfaction of
13 liabilities.

14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to the
15 collection of any judgment, regardless of whether the judgment was
16 entered before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.

17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
