- 5 SECTION 1. Section 31.002(a), Civil Practice and Remedies
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 31.002. COLLECTION OF JUDGMENT THROUGH COURT
- 8 PROCEEDING. (a) A judgment creditor is entitled to aid from a
- 9 court of appropriate jurisdiction, including a justice court,
- 10 through injunction or other means in order to reach property to
- 11 obtain satisfaction on the judgment if the judgment debtor owns
- 12 property, including present or future rights to property, that is
- 13 not exempt from attachment, execution, or seizure for the
- 14 satisfaction of liabilities.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to the
- 16 collection of any judgment, regardless of whether the judgment was
- 17 entered before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
