A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the collection of certain judgments through court
3 proceeding.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 31.002(a), Civil Practice and Remedies
6 Code, is amended to read as follows:

7 Sec. 31.002. COLLECTION OF JUDGMENT THROUGH COURT
8 PROCEEDING. (a) A judgment creditor is entitled to aid from a
9 court of appropriate jurisdiction, including a justice court,
10 through injunction or other means in order to reach property to
11 obtain satisfaction on the judgment if the judgment debtor owns
12 property, including present or future rights to property, that is
13 not exempt from attachment, execution, or seizure for the
14 satisfaction of liabilities.

15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to the
16 collection of any judgment, regardless of whether the judgment was
17 entered before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.

18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
