S.B. No. 2397

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to criminal history record information for applicants for
3 employment with the ombudsman for children and youth in foster
4 care.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 411.1106(b), Government Code, is amended
7 to read as follows:

8 (b) The executive commissioner of the commission, or the
9 executive commissioner's designee, is entitled to obtain from the
10 department criminal history record information maintained by the
11 department that relates to a person who is:

12 (1) an applicant for employment for a position in
13 which the person, as an employee, would have access to sensitive
14 personal or financial information, as determined by the executive
15 commissioner, in:

16 (A) the eligibility services division of the
17 commission; ~~or~~

18 (B) the commission's office of inspector
19 general; or

20 (C) the commission's office of the ombudsman for
21 children and youth in foster care; or

22 (2) an employee of the commission who has access to
23 sensitive personal or financial information, as determined by the
24 executive commissioner.

1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
