4	SECTION 1. Section 38.04(b), Penal Code, as amended by
5	Chapters 391 (S.B. 496), 839 (H.B. 3423), and 920 (S.B. 1416), Acts
6	of the 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011, is reenacted and
7	amended to read as follows:
8	(b) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor,
9	except that the offense is:
10	(1) a state jail felony if the actor has been
11	previously convicted under this section;
12	(2) a felony of the third degree if:
13	(A) the actor uses a vehicle or watercraft while

- (B) another suffers serious bodily injury as a 15 direct result of the actor fleeing an attempt by the officer or 16
- 17 investigator [from whom the actor is fleeing] to apprehend the
- actor [while the actor is in flight]; or 18
- 19 (C) the actor uses a tire deflation device
- against the officer or investigator while the actor is in flight; or 20
- 21 (3) a felony of the second degree if:
- another suffers death as a direct result of 22 (A)
- the actor fleeing an attempt by the officer or investigator [from 23
- whom the actor is fleeing] to apprehend the actor [while the actor 24

- 1 is in flight]; [or]
- 2 (B) another suffers serious bodily injury as a
- 3 direct result of the actor's use of a tire deflation device while
- 4 the actor is in flight; or
- 5 (C) the actor uses a vehicle or watercraft while
- 6 the actor is in flight and the actor has been previously convicted
- 7 under this section.
- 8 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 9 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 10 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 11 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 12 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 13 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 14 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 15 committed before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
