## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to authorization by the Texas Higher Education 3 Coordinating Board for certain public junior colleges to offer 4 baccalaureate degree programs.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 130.306, Education Code, is amended by 7 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (d) to read as 8 follows:

9 (b) Except as provided by <u>Subsections</u> [<del>Subsection</del>] (a) <u>and</u> 10 <u>(d)</u>, a public junior college offering a baccalaureate degree 11 program under this subchapter may not offer more than three 12 baccalaureate degree programs at any time.

13 (d) A public junior college offering a baccalaureate degree 14 program under this subchapter that is located in a county with a 15 population of more than 1.8 million and that is located within 180 16 miles of the Texas-Mexico border may not offer more than six 17 baccalaureate degree programs at any time.

18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
