## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 67, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 67.28 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 67.28. COORDINATED ADMISSION PROGRAM. In
- 9 administering the Coordinated Admission Program (CAP) or a
- 10 <u>successor admissions program under which a student may earn</u>
- 11 guaranteed transfer admission to the university after successfully
- 12 completing specified program requirements while enrolled for the
- 13 student's freshman year at another participating institution of
- 14 higher education within The University of Texas System, the
- 15 university, in allotting CAP admission slots among participating
- 16 institutions for an academic year, shall reserve a portion of
- 17 admission slots at each participating institution for students who
- 18 are enrolled at that institution at the time they apply for
- 19 admission to CAP.
- 20 SECTION 2. Section 67.28, Education Code, as added by this
- 21 Act, applies beginning with admissions to the Coordinated Admission
- 22 Program at The University of Texas at Austin for the 2020-2021
- 23 academic year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
