A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the use of tax revenue by certain municipalities for the
3	payment of certain hotel-related bonds or other obligations.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections 351.102(e) and (g), Tax Code, are
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(e) In addition to the municipalities described by Subsection
8	(b), that subsection also applies to:
9	(1) a municipality with a population of at least 110,000
10	but not more than 135,000 at least part of which is located in a
11	county with a population of not more than 135,000;
12	(2) a municipality with a population of at least 9,000
13	but not more than 10,000 that is located in two counties, each of
14	which has a population of at least 662,000 and a southern border
15	with a county with a population of 2.3 million or more;
16	(3) a municipality with a population of at least 200,000
17	but not more than 300,000 that contains a component institution of
18	the Texas Tech University System;
19	(4) a municipality with a population of at least 95,000
20	that borders Lake Lewisville;
21	(5) a municipality that:
22	(A) contains a portion of Cedar Hill State Park;
23	(B) has a population of more than 45,000;

(C) is located in two counties, one of which has a

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- 1 population of more than two million and one of which has a
- 2 population of more than 149,000; and
- 3 (D) has adopted a capital improvement plan for the
- 4 construction or expansion of a convention center facility;
- 5 (6) a municipality with a population of less than 6,000
- 6 that:
- 7 (A) is located in two counties each with a
- 8 population of 600,000 or more that are both adjacent to a county
- 9 with a population of two million or more;
- 10 (B) has full-time police and fire departments; and
- 11 (C) has adopted a capital improvement plan for the
- 12 construction or expansion of a convention center facility;
- 13 (7) a municipality with a population of at least 56,000
- 14 that:
- 15 (A) borders Lake Ray Hubbard; and
- 16 (B) is located in two counties, one of which has a
- 17 population of less than 80,000;
- 18 (8) a municipality with a population of more than
- 19 83,000, that borders Clear Lake, and that is primarily located in a
- 20 county with a population of less than 300,000;
- 21 (9) a municipality with a population of less than 2,000
- 22 that:
- 23 (A) is located adjacent to a bay connected to the
- 24 Gulf of Mexico;
- 25 (B) is located in a county with a population of
- 26 290,000 or more that is adjacent to a county with a population of
- 27 four million or more; and

(C) has a boardwalk on the bay; 1 2 (10) a municipality with a population of 75,000 or more that: 3 located wholly in one county with a 4 population of 575,000 or more that is adjacent to a county with a 5 population of four million or more; and 6 7 (B) has adopted a capital improvement plan for the construction or expansion of a convention center facility; 8 9 (11) a municipality with a population of less than 75,000 that is located in three counties, at least one of which has 10 11 a population of at least four million; [and] (12) an eligible coastal municipality with a population 12 of more than 3,000 but less than 5,000; and 13 14 (13) a municipality with a population of 6,100 or less 15 that: 16 (A) is located in two counties one with a population of 788,400 or more and the other county with a population 17 of 666,700 or more; and 18 (B) contains a portion of state highway 289. 19 (g) A municipality to which this section applies may not 20 receive or pledge revenue or funds under Subsection (b) or (c) for a 21 hotel project unless the municipality enters into an agreement with 22 a person for the development of the hotel project before September 23 1,2019. 24 25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
