- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 375.262, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 375.262. DISSOLUTION BY PETITION BY OWNERS. Except as
- 8 limited by Section 375.264, the board shall dissolve the district
- 9 on written petition filed with the board by the owners of:
- 10 (1) $\underline{50}$ [75] percent or more of the assessed value of
- 11 the property in the district based on the most recent certified
- 12 county property tax rolls; or
- 13 (2) $\underline{50}$ [75] percent or more of the surface area of the
- 14 district, excluding roads, streets, highways, utility
- 15 rights-of-way, other public areas, and other property exempt from
- 16 assessment under Sections 375.161, 375.163, and 375.164, according
- 17 to the most recent certified county property tax rolls.
- SECTION 2. Section 68.352(b), Water Code, is amended to
- 19 read as follows:
- 20 (b) The board shall dissolve the district on written
- 21 petition filed with the board by the owners of:
- (1) 75 percent or more of the assessed value of the
- 23 property in the district based on the most recent certified county
- 24 property tax rolls; or

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- 1 (2) 75 percent or more of the surface area of the
 2 district, excluding roads, streets, highways, utility
 3 rights-of-way, other public areas, and other property exempt from
 4 assessment under this chapter, according to the most recent
 5 certified county property tax rolls [A district may be dissolved as
 6 provided by Section 375.262, Local Covernment Code].
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
