## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the administration, powers, and duties of
- 3 self-liquidating navigation districts.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 63, Water Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 63.1045 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 63.1045. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR. (a) The district may
- 8 employ an executive director of the district. If the district
- 9 employs an executive director, the district must prescribe the
- 10 duties and compensation of the executive director.
- 11 (b) The duties of an executive director may be performed by
- 12 <u>a general manager, port director, or chief executive officer.</u>
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 63.105, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 14 follows:
- Sec. 63.105. ENGINEER. The district [commission] may
- 16 employ a competent engineer whose term of office and compensation
- 17 shall be determined by the <u>district</u> [commission].
- 18 SECTION 3. Section 63.107, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 19 follows:
- Sec. 63.107. DISTRICT EMPLOYEES. (a) The <u>district:</u>
- 21 <u>(1)</u> [commission] may employ assistant engineers and
- 22 other persons as it considers necessary for the construction,
- 23 maintenance, operation, and development of the district and  $[\tau]$  its
- 24 business and facilities;  $[\tau]$  and

- 1 (2) shall determine their term of office and duties  $[\tau]$
- 2 and fix their compensation.
- 3 (b) All employees may be removed by the district
- 4 [commission].
- 5 SECTION 4. Section 63.109, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 63.109. PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES. The
- 8 <u>district</u> [<del>commission</del>] may draw warrants, issue checks, or use a
- 9 payment method adopted under Section 60.271 to pay for:
- 10  $\underline{\text{(1)}}$  [legal] services;
- 11 (2) [, for] the compensation [salaries] of [the
- 12 engineer, his assistant, or any other] employees; and
- 13 (3) [, and for] all expenses incident and relating to
- 14 the district.
- 15 SECTION 5. The heading to Section 63.175, Water Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 63.175. SUPERVISION OF WORK [BY ENGINEER].
- SECTION 6. Section 63.175(a), Water Code, is amended to
- 19 read as follows:
- 20 (a) Unless done under the supervision of the United States,
- 21 all work contracted for by the <u>district</u> [commission] shall be done
- 22 under the supervision of a representative of the district
- 23 [engineer].
- SECTION 7. Sections 63.176(a) and (b), Water Code, are
- 25 amended to read as follows:
- 26 (a) A representative of the district [The commission] shall
- 27 inspect the work being done during its progress, and on completion

- 1 of the contract, the <u>district</u> [commission] shall draw a warrant on
- 2 the district depository or issue a check in favor of the contractor
- 3 or the contractor's [his] assignee for the amount of the contract
- 4 price. The warrant or check shall be paid from the construction and
- 5 maintenance or operating fund.
- 6 (b) If the <u>district</u> [commission] considers it advisable, it
- 7 may contract to pay for the work in partial payments as the work
- 8 progresses. Partial[ , but the partial] payments may not be more in
- 9 the aggregate than the amount allowed under applicable laws [90]
- 10 percent of the contract price of the total amount of work done under
- 11 the contract]. The amount of the work shall be shown by a
- 12 certificate of <u>a representative of</u> the <u>district</u> [engineer].
- SECTION 8. Subchapter D, Chapter 63, Water Code, is amended
- 14 by adding Section 63.184 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 63.184. DISPOSITION OF SALVAGE OR SURPLUS PROPERTY.
- 16 The commission may authorize the executive director or the
- 17 executive director's designee to sell, destroy, donate, or
- 18 otherwise dispose of the district's surplus or salvage personal
- 19 property by any method the executive director or the executive
- 20 director's designee determines is in the best interest of the
- 21 <u>district.</u>
- 22 SECTION 9. Section 63.175(b), Water Code, is repealed.
- 23 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 24 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 25 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 26 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 27 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
