involving a testamentary trust, whether the matter is appertaining 1 2 to or incident to an estate; 3 (D) in [(1)] family law cases and proceedings; 4 and 5 (E) in [(2)] felony cases to conduct 6 arraignments, conduct pretrial hearings, and accept guilty pleas. 7 SECTION 2. Section 25.1392(a), Government Code, as amended 8 by this Act, applies only to a cause of action filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A cause of action filed before the 9 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the 10 date the cause of action was filed, and the former law is continued 11 in effect for that purpose. 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019. 13
