| 8 | Sec. 83.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter: |
| 9 | (1) "Employee" means an individual who is employed by |
| 10 | an employer for compensation. |
| 11 | (2) "Employer" means a person who employs one or more |
| 12 | employees. |
| 13 | (3) "Employment benefit" means anything of value that |
| 14 | an employee receives from an employer in addition to monetary |
| 15 | compensation. |
| 16 | Sec. 83.002. PROHIBITED LOCAL REGULATIONS. (a) A |
| 17 | political subdivision of this state may not adopt or enforce any |
| 18 | ordinance, order, rule, regulation, or policy regulating a private |
| 19 | employer's terms of employment relating to employment benefits |
| 20 | other than employment leave, including health, disability, |
| 21 | retirement, profit-sharing, death, and group accidental death and |
| 22 | dismemberment benefits. |
| 23 | (b) An ordinance, order, rule, regulation, or policy that |
| 24 | violates this section is void and unenforceable. |

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1 SECTION 2. Chapter 83, Labor Code, as added by this Act, 2 applies to an ordinance, order, rule, regulation, or policy adopted 3 before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.

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4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
