- 8 CHAPTER 83. PROHIBITION AGAINST LOCAL REGULATION OF CERTAIN
- 9 EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES
- 10 Sec. 83.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
- 11 (1) "Employee" means an individual who is employed by
- 12 <u>an employer for compensation.</u>
- 13 (2) "Employer" means a person who employs one or more
- 14 employees.
- 15 Sec. 83.002. LOCAL REGULATION OF EMPLOYER SCHEDULING
- 16 PRACTICES OR OVERTIME COMPENSATION PROHIBITED. (a) A political
- 17 subdivision of this state may not adopt or enforce an ordinance,
- 18 order, rule, regulation, or policy regulating a private employer's
- 19 terms of employment relating to scheduling practices or overtime
- 20 compensation.
- 21 (b) An ordinance, order, rule, regulation, or policy that
- 22 <u>violates Subsection (a) is void and unenforceable.</u>
- Sec. 83.003. EFFECT OF CHAPTER. This chapter does not
- 24 affect:

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- 1 (1) the Texas Minimum Wage Act under Chapter 62; or
- 2 (2) an ordinance, order, rule, regulation, or policy
- 3 that prohibits employment discrimination, regardless of whether
- 4 the ordinance, order, rule, regulation, or policy is adopted
- 5 before, on, or after September 1, 2019.
- 6 SECTION 2. Chapter 83, Labor Code, as added by this Act,
- 7 applies to an ordinance, order, rule, regulation, or policy adopted
- 8 before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
