## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the powers and authorities of municipal utility
- 3 districts.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 54.234(a), Water Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) Any district or any petitioner seeking the creation of a
- 8 district may petition the commission to acquire the power under the
- 9 authority of Article III, Section 52, Texas Constitution, to
- 10 design, acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for, operate,
- 11 maintain, and convey to this state, a county, or a municipality for
- 12 operation and maintenance, a road [described by Subsection (b)] or
- 13 any improvement in aid of the road.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 54.801(a), Water Code, is amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 (a) A district that is composed of at least  $1,000 [\frac{1,500}{}]$
- 17 acres may define areas or designate certain property of the
- 18 district to pay for improvements, facilities, or services that
- 19 primarily benefit that area or property and do not generally and
- 20 directly benefit the district as a whole.
- SECTION 3. Section 54.802(b), Water Code, is amended to
- 22 read as follows:
- 23 (b) The board shall file an engineer's report [adopt a
- 24 proposed plan] for improvements in the defined area or to serve the

- 1 designated property [in the manner provided by Section 49.106].
- 2 SECTION 4. Section 54.805, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 Sec. 54.805. OBTAINING FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT, ADMINISTER,
- 5 MAINTAIN, AND OPERATE IMPROVEMENTS AND FACILITIES IN DEFINED AREAS
- 6 OR DESIGNATED PROPERTY. On adoption of the proposed plan [plans] as
- 7 provided by this subchapter [Section 54.804 of this code] and voter
- 8 approval of taxes and bonds [the plans], the district, under the
- 9 limitations of this subchapter, may apply separately, differently,
- 10 equitably, and specifically its taxing power and lien authority to
- 11 the defined area or designated property to provide money to
- 12 construct, administer, maintain, and operate improvements and
- 13 facilities that primarily benefit the defined area or designated
- 14 property.
- 15 SECTION 5. Section 54.806(a), Water Code, is amended to
- 16 read as follows:
- 17 (a) Before bonds may be issued or taxes may be levied for the
- 18 defined area or designated property [the adopted plans may become
- 19 effective], they must be approved by the voters in the defined area
- 20 or within the boundaries of the designated property. The election
- 21 shall be conducted as provided by Section 49.106 for an election to
- 22 authorize the issuance of bonds or Section 49.107 for an election to
- 23 <u>authorize an operation and maintenance tax</u>.
- SECTION 6. Section 54.809, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 25 follows:
- Sec. 54.809. ISSUANCE OF BONDS AND LEVY OF TAX FOR DEFINED
- 27 AREA OR DESIGNATED PROPERTY. After approval by the voters [the

- 1  $\frac{\text{order is recorded}}{\text{order of the district may issue its bonds}}$  and levy taxes
- 2 to provide the specific plant, works, and facilities included in
- 3 the engineer's report [plans adopted] for the defined area, or to
- 4 serve the designated property [and shall provide the plant, works,
- 5 and facilities].
- 6 SECTION 7. Section 54.812(b), Water Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b) The prescribed notice shall be inserted into the general
- 9 notice after the first sentence and shall read substantially as
- 10 follows: "The real property described below, which you are about to
- 11 purchase, may [is] also be located within a defined [designated]
- 12 area of the district and your land may [will] be subject to defined
- 13 area taxes in addition to the [a higher tax than] other taxes of
- 14 [land within] the district. As of this date, the additional [Your]
- 15 rate of taxes within the defined area is [will be higher by] \$\_\_\_\_\_
- 16 on each \$100 of assessed valuation [than land not within the
- 17 designated area]."
- 18 SECTION 8. Sections 54.234(b), 54.803, 54.804(a), 54.807,
- 19 and 54.808, Water Code, are repealed.
- 20 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
