6	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
7	is amended by adding Section 521.1251 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 521.1251. OPTIONAL DESIGNATIONS FOR BLOOD TYPE AND
9	BLOOD DISORDERS. (a) The department shall provide to each
10	applicant for the issuance of an original, renewal, corrected, or
11	duplicate driver's license or personal identification certificate
12	who applies in person, by mail, over the Internet, or by other
13	electronic means the opportunity to indicate on the person's
14	driver's license or personal identification certificate:
15	(1) the person's blood type; and
16	(2) whether the person has a blood disorder and, if so,
17	the type of blood disorder.
18	(b) The department shall include on each driver's license
19	issued to a person who makes an election under this section a
20	designation that indicates the person's blood type and blood
21	disorder, as applicable.
22	SECTION 2. Section 522.030, Transportation Code, is amended
23	by adding Subsections (e) and (f) to read as follows:
24	(e) The department shall provide to each applicant for the

14 SECTION 3. The Department of Public Safety shall adopt 15 rules as necessary to implement Sections 521.1251 and 522.030(e) 16 and (f), Transportation Code, as added by this Act, not later than 17 November 1, 2019.

18 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
