

1 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 BE IT RESOLVED by the 86th Legislature, That a joint  
3 committee, composed of six members of the senate appointed by the  
4 lieutenant governor and six members of the house of representatives  
5 appointed by the speaker of the house, arrange for the canvass of  
6 the votes cast for governor and lieutenant governor at the general  
7 election held on November 6, 2018, and that a joint session of the  
8 senate and house be held in the hall of the house of representatives  
9 at 12 noon on Thursday, January 10, 2019, for the purpose of  
10 counting the votes, receiving the report, and hearing the  
11 declaration of the results of the canvass; and, be it further

12 RESOLVED, That the senate and house of representatives sit in  
13 joint session at 11 a.m. on Tuesday, January 15, 2019, for the  
14 inauguration of the governor-elect and lieutenant governor-elect  
15 of Texas as determined by the canvass of the votes; and, be it  
16 further

17 RESOLVED, That a joint committee, composed of five members of  
18 the senate appointed by the lieutenant governor and five members of  
19 the house of representatives appointed by the speaker of the house,  
20 make arrangements for the joint session and oath-taking ceremony on  
21 January 15, 2019; and, be it further

22 RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Safety of the State  
23 of Texas is instructed to close all vehicle entrances to the Capitol  
24 grounds beginning at 5 p.m. on Monday, January 14, 2019, and ending

1 at 11:59 p.m. on Tuesday, January 15, 2019, except for those  
2 vehicles approved by the inaugural committee as necessary for use  
3 in connection with the joint session and oath-taking ceremony and  
4 the program following.
