1 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Texan Kacey Musgraves won four trophies at the 2019  
3 Grammy Awards, including the most prestigious, Album of the Year,  
4 for *Golden Hour*; and

5 WHEREAS, A native of Golden, Texas, Ms. Musgraves also took  
6 home the award for Best Country Album, and she received Best Country  
7 Song for "Space Cowboy" and best country solo performance for  
8 "Butterflies"; *Golden Hour*, which blends country instrumentation  
9 and electronic elements, has received wide critical acclaim, and it  
10 was previously named Album of the Year by the Country Music  
11 Association; and

12 WHEREAS, Ms. Musgraves began playing mandolin and writing  
13 songs in elementary school, and during adolescence, she released a  
14 number of albums on independent labels; after high school, she  
15 worked on her craft in Austin and appeared on the television  
16 competition *Nashville Star* before signing with Mercury Nashville in  
17 2012; and

18 WHEREAS, With her first major-label album, *Same Trailer*  
19 *Different Park*, Ms. Musgraves debuted at No. 2 on *Billboard's* "Top  
20 200" chart, and she scored three hit singles; she continued to gain  
21 fans with her follow-up album, *Pageant Material*, and she offered  
22 her listeners a holiday treat in 2016 with the retro sounds of *A*  
23 *Very Kacey Christmas*; and

24 WHEREAS, Kacey Musgraves has brought joy to innumerable

1 people through her music, and she may take justifiable pride in the  
2 national recognition she has garnered; now, therefore, be it

3       RESOLVED, That the 86th Legislature of the State of Texas  
4 hereby congratulate Kacey Musgraves on her receipt of four 2019  
5 Grammy Awards and extend to her sincere best wishes for continued  
6 success; and, be it further
