CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Texan Kacey Musgraves won four trophies at the 2019
2 Grammy Awards, including the most prestigious, Album of the Year,
3 for *Golden Hour*; and

4 WHEREAS, A native of Golden, Texas, Ms. Musgraves also took
5 home the award for Best Country Album, and she received Best Country
6 Song for "Space Cowboy" and best country solo performance for
7 "Butterflies"; *Golden Hour*, which blends country instrumentation
8 and electronic elements, has received wide critical acclaim, and it
9 was previously named Album of the Year by the Country Music
10 Association; and

11 WHEREAS, Ms. Musgraves began playing mandolin and writing
12 songs in elementary school, and during adolescence, she released a
13 number of albums on independent labels; after high school, she
14 worked on her craft in Austin and appeared on the television
15 competition *Nashville Star* before signing with Mercury Nashville in
16 2012; and

17 WHEREAS, With her first major-label album, *Same Trailer*
18 *Different Park*, Ms. Musgraves debuted at No. 2 on *Billboard's* "Top
19 200" chart, and she scored three hit singles; she continued to gain
20 fans with her follow-up album, *Pageant Material*, and she offered
21 her listeners a holiday treat in 2016 with the retro sounds of *A*
22 *Very Kacey Christmas*; and

23 WHEREAS, Kacey Musgraves has brought joy to innumerable
24 people through her music, and she may take justifiable pride in the

1 national recognition she has garnered; now, therefore, be it

2 RESOLVED, That the 86th Legislature of the State of Texas
3 hereby congratulate Kacey Musgraves on her receipt of four 2019
4 Grammy Awards and extend to her sincere best wishes for continued
5 success; and, be it further
