9 RESOLVED, The State of Texas recognizes the need of
10 protecting the Texas coast; any structure on Bolivar Peninsula
11 should protect not damage the community; and, be it further

12 RESOLVED, That the Texas secretary of state forward official
13 copies of this resolution to the commissioner of the Texas General
14 Land Office, the United States Army Corps of Engineers, and to all
15 members of the Texas delegation to Congress with the request that
16 this resolution be officially entered in the Congressional Record.
