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CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Like many other states, Texas incorporates 2 noncontroversial technical and procedural changes into its 3 insurance statutes by reference to the model laws and regulations 4 of the National Association of Insurance Commissioners; this 5 practice is known as incorporation by reference; and

6 WHEREAS, An example of incorporation by reference is Section 7 421.001(c), Insurance Code, which requires the commissioner of 8 insurance to adopt each current formula recommended by the National 9 Association of Insurance Commissioners for establishing reserves 10 for each line of insurance; and

11 WHEREAS, Another example is Section 541.401(b)(2), Insurance 12 Code, which authorizes the commissioner of insurance to adopt a 13 rulemaking provision the commissioner considers necessary to 14 conform to the adopted procedures of the National Association of 15 Insurance Commissioners; and

16 WHEREAS, There is concern that incorporation by reference in 17 the Texas Insurance Code is an unconstitutional delegation of 18 legislative authority, and a study would help to determine the 19 appropriateness of using National Association of Insurance 20 Commissioners model laws and regulations instead of passing laws 21 specific to Texas; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the 86th Legislature of the State of Texas hereby request the lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house of representatives to create a joint interim committee to study the

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use of incorporation by reference in the Texas Insurance Code; and,
be it further

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3 RESOLVED, That the committee submit a full report, including 4 findings and recommendations, to the 87th Texas Legislature before 5 it convenes in January 2021; and, be it further

6 RESOLVED, That the committee's proceedings and operations be 7 governed by such general rules and policies for interim committees 8 as the 86th Texas Legislature may adopt.

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
