CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1           WHEREAS, The valiant military service of Harold A. Fritz is  
2 being saluted as part of the 2019 Medal of Honor Host City Weekend  
3 in Gainesville; and

4           WHEREAS, Established in 2001, Gainesville's Medal of Honor  
5 Host City Program acknowledges the heroism and sacrifice of  
6 individuals who have earned the Medal of Honor, the nation's  
7 highest military award for valor; each year, local citizens join  
8 together to fund travel costs and other expenses to bring medal  
9 recipients to the city for a special series of events; and

10           WHEREAS, A veteran of the U.S. Army, Captain Harold Fritz  
11 served during the Vietnam War as a first lieutenant in Troop A, 1st  
12 Squadron, 11th Armored Cavalry Regiment; seriously wounded when the  
13 armored column he was leading came under intense fire, he exhibited  
14 exceptional selflessness as the platoon leader, tending to and  
15 encouraging his injured comrades; he subsequently manned a machine  
16 gun to protect the enemy-surrounded convoy and then, armed only  
17 with a pistol and bayonet, led a daring charge that routed the enemy  
18 combatants; after directing the deployment of a relief force, he  
19 refused medical attention until all of the wounded soldiers in his  
20 unit had been treated and evacuated; and

21           WHEREAS, Demonstrating extraordinary courage in the line of  
22 duty, Harold Fritz fulfilled the highest ideals of the United  
23 States armed forces, and he has earned the lasting admiration of a  
24 grateful nation; now, therefore, be it

1           RESOLVED, That the 86th Legislature of the State of Texas  
2 hereby pay tribute to Harold A. Fritz on the occasion of the 2019  
3 Medal of Honor Host City Weekend in Gainesville and commend him for  
4 his exemplary service in the defense of our nation; and, be it  
5 further

6           RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
7 prepared for Mr. Fritz as an expression of high regard by the Texas  
8 House of Representatives and Senate.
