- 1 WHEREAS, The valiant military service of Robert R. Ingram is
- 2 being saluted as part of the 2019 Medal of Honor Host City Weekend
- 3 in Gainesville; and
- WHEREAS, Established in 2001, Gainesville's Medal of Honor
- 5 Host City Program acknowledges the heroism and sacrifice of
- 6 individuals who have earned the Medal of Honor, the nation's
- 7 highest military award for valor; each year, local citizens join
- 8 together to fund travel costs and other expenses to bring medal
- 9 recipients to the city for a special series of events; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Petty Officer Ingram served in the United States
- 11 Navy as a corpsman with Company C, 1st Battalion, 7th Marines, 1st
- 12 Marine Division during the Vietnam War; on March 28, 1966, his
- 13 platoon was attacked by the North Vietnamese in Quang Ngai
- 14 Province; without regard for his personal safety, he crawled across
- 15 a fire-swept, bullet-spattered landscape to administer aid to the
- 16 wounded and collect ammunition from the dead; he was shot four times
- 17 that day, and despite being critically injured, he pushed, pulled,
- 18 consoled, and doctored his marines, single-handedly saving many
- 19 lives while risking his own; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Demonstrating extraordinary courage in the line of
- 21 duty, Robert Ingram fulfilled the highest ideals of the United
- 22 States armed forces, and he has earned the lasting admiration of a
- 23 grateful nation; now, therefore, be it
