SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1-16 WHEREAS, The art form of mosaic is a 6,000-year-old technique 1-17 in which small pieces of glass, stone, or other materials are used 1-18 to create a pattern or a mural; and

1-19 WHEREAS, In the City of Levelland, artists have used this 1-20 ancient art form to portray a visual history of Hockley County and 1-21 to tell the story of its people and their achievements; and

1-22 WHEREAS, In 1968, Don Stroud, then an art professor at South 1-23 Plains College, created and installed the first mosaic work in 1-24 Levelland; the piece was made with glass tiles, which he had 1-25 acquired in Mexico, and he and his children installed the mosaic, 1-26 entitled *Wild Mustangs*, in the Fine Arts Building at the college; 1-27 and

1-27 and 1-28 WHEREAS, In the years since, additional mosaic works by Don 1-29 Stroud and other talented artists have been installed at the 1-30 college and at locations throughout the city; pieces like Hockley 1-31 County: Past to Present and Land of Soil, Oil, and Education, as 1-32 well as Hockley County Schools and Your Children's Children, 1-33 recount the area's history, and such works as Tree of Life, Arms of 1-34 Care, and New Morning celebrate the significant roles that the 1-35 medical profession and educational institutions play in the 1-36 community; and

1-37 WHEREAS, Today, Levelland is home to 13 of these distinctive 1-38 murals, which have engaged the citizenry and raised interest in the 1-39 arts and culture; local artists and city officials have worked 1-40 diligently to ensure that the mosaics are kept in pristine 1-41 condition, and a self-guided tour of the mosaics is a popular 1-42 activity for residents and visitors to the city; and

1-42 activity for residents and visitors to the city; and 1-43 WHEREAS, Over the years, Levelland has become known 1-44 throughout the area as the City of Mosaics due to the many 1-45 captivating mosaic murals that adorn the city's landscape; now, 1-46 therefore, be it

1-47 RESOLVED, That the 86th Legislature of the State of Texas 1-48 hereby designate Levelland as the official City of Mosaics of 1-49 Texas; and, be it further

1-50 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of Section 1-51 391.003(e), Government Code, this designation remain in effect 1-52 until the 10th anniversary of its designation.
