A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to prohibit an appraisal
- 2 district or the appraisal review board for an appraisal district
- 3 from requiring a property owner to pay a fee in connection with a
- 4 protest filed by the owner with the board.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 18, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is
- 7 amended by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (c-1) An appraisal entity or the board of equalization for
- 9 <u>an appraisal entity may not require a property owner to pay a fee in</u>
- 10 connection with a protest filed by the owner with the board of an
- 11 action that the Legislature by general law authorizes to be the
- 12 <u>subject of a protest.</u>
- 13 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 14 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019.
- 15 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 16 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to prohibit an
- 17 appraisal district or the appraisal review board for an appraisal
- 18 district from requiring a property owner to pay a fee in connection
- 19 with a protest filed by the owner with the board.
