1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 2, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is
- 8 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 9 <u>(e)</u> The Legislature by general law may provide that a person
- 10 who owns property located in an area declared by the governor to be
- 11 a disaster area following a disaster is entitled to a temporary
- 12 exemption from ad valorem taxation by a political subdivision of a
- 13 portion of the appraised value of that property. The Legislature by
- 14 general law may prescribe the method of determining the amount of
- 15 the exemption authorized by this subsection and the duration of the
- 16 exemption and may provide additional eligibility requirements for
- 17 the exemption.
- 18 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 19 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019.
- 20 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 21 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 22 legislature to provide for a temporary exemption from ad valorem
- 23 taxation of a portion of the appraised value of certain property
- 24 damaged by a disaster."
