Association of Secondary School Principals; furthermore, he was a statewide appointee to a committee for the Principals' Incentive Program under Governor George W. Bush; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Deason holds a bachelor's degree in speech pathology and educational psychology, a master's degree in education and special education, and a doctorate in educational leadership and general administration from Stephen F. Austin State University; and

WHEREAS, Through his dedication, professionalism, and commitment to excellence, Dr. Ray Deason helped foster a supportive and challenging educational environment for countless students in the Lone Star State, and his contributions will continue to resonate for years to come; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate of the State of Texas, 86th Legislature, hereby congratulate Dr. Ray Deason on his retirement as assistant superintendent of the Ore City Independent School District and extend to him sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further
