WHEREAS, Hospice care provides humane and comforting support for terminally ill patients and their families; hospice care includes pain control, palliative medical care, and social, emotional, and spiritual services; and

WHEREAS, Hospice fulfills the basic human need of feeling comfortable in familiar surroundings and of attaining physical and emotional peace during the last stage of life; and

WHEREAS, There is a growing need to increase public discussion about the advances in pain control and the care options available to individuals of all ages, races, and backgrounds who are at the end of life; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate of the State of Texas, 86th Legislature, hereby proclaim March 13, 2019, Home Care and Hospice Awareness Day and encourage the support and participation of all citizens in learning more about home care and hospice care for the elderly, disabled, and the terminally ill.
