WHEREAS, It is truly fitting that time be dedicated to raising awareness of the need for research on treatments and cures for bleeding disorders and of the importance of advocacy on behalf of those affected by the disorders; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate of the State of Texas, 86th Legislature, hereby commend those working to prevent and treat bleeding disorders and extend to them best wishes for a productive Bleeding Disorders Awareness Month; and, be it further
