WHEREAS, Philosophically a strict constructionist, he is known for his meticulous preparation for cases and his genuine passion for his work; he has been active in a number of professional and civic organizations, including the Texas Bar Foundation and the Eastland Independent School District board of trustees, and he also serves as the pastor of First Christian Church, Disciples of Christ in Eastland; and

WHEREAS, An exemplary jurist, Chief Justice Wright is respected and admired by his colleagues for his fairness and impartiality, his thorough knowledge of the law, and his passion for serving the public good; it is truly fitting that he receive special recognition; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate of the State of Texas, 86th Legislature, hereby commend Chief Justice Jim R. Wright on his many contributions to the justice system in our state and extend to him best wishes for continued success in all his endeavors; and, be it further
