**IN RE: HB95** by Hinojosa (Relating to the criminal offense of acquisition or attempted acquisition of a firearm by a person prohibited from possessing a firearm.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

It is assumed that the provisions of the bill relating to the criminal offense of acquisition or attempted acquisition of a firearm by a person prohibited from possessing a firearm could be absorbed using existing resources. This analysis assumes the provisions of the bill would not result in a significant impact on the demand for state correctional resources.
