**IN RE: HB356** by Lang (Relating to the repeal of a statute allowing the county attorney or commissioners court of Brown County to accept gifts or grants to finance or assist the operation of the office of county attorney.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Government Code to eliminate a provision allowing the commissioners court of certain counties to accept certain gifts or grants.

According to the Office of Court Administration (OCA), no significant fiscal impact to the state court system is anticipated.

**Local Government Impact**

The fiscal implications on counties impacted by provisions of the bill cannot be determined at this time.
