IN RE: HB366 by González, Mary (Relating to healthy relationships education in public schools.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that the provisions of the bill relating to healthy relationships education could be absorbed using existing resources.

Local Government Impact

The bill would require school districts to provide healthy relationships education. School districts could see increased costs related to professional development, purchasing instructional materials, and updating course curricula related to this topic; these costs would vary by school district.
