IN RE: HB406 by Price (Relating to organ donor registration information when applying for a hunting or fishing license on the Internet.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Parks and Wildlife Code related to registration as an organ donor when applying for a hunting or fishing license. The Parks and Wildlife Department would be required to add a link on its website to the Glenda Dawson Donate Life - Texas Registry. Based on analysis of the Parks and Wildlife Department, duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the bill provisions could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
