**IN RE:** **HB467** by Hernandez (Relating to sexual assault and domestic violence awareness continuing education for cosmetology license holders.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

The bill would require the Commission of Licensing and Regulation to require cosmetology continuing education programs to include information on sexual assault and domestic violence awareness. The bill would take effect September 1, 2019.
