IN RE: HB488 by Springer (Relating to the protection of public freshwater areas.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Parks and Wildlife Code to repeal Section 90.003(b) regarding exemptions for the operation of motor vehicles in protected freshwater areas.

The Texas Parks and Wildlife Department indicates that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.
