**IN RE: HB554** by Thompson, Senfronia (Relating to temporary orders during the pendency of an appeal in a suit affecting the parent-child relationship.), **As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend Family Code to change "spouses" to "parties" when rendering a temporary order enjoining a party from molesting or disturbing the peace of a child or another party. Based on the analysis of the Office of Court Administration, duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished using existing resources.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2019.
