IN RE: HB652 by Neave (Relating to an exception from requirements to assist or cooperate with federal immigration officers for matters regarding activities that occur at a domestic violence shelter.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend the Government Code to extend an existing exception to certain requirements that local entities assist or cooperate with federal immigration officers to include activities that occur at domestic violence shelters.
