**IN RE: HB815** by Kuempel (Relating to the authority of a county to require photo identification to file certain documents with the county clerk.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to expand to statewide effect an existing requirement that certain counties may require photo identification to file certain documents with the county clerk.
