IN RE: HB872 by Hefner (Relating to financial assistance paid to the survivors of certain law enforcement officers and other public employees killed in the line of duty.), As Passed 2nd House

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Government Code regarding financial assistance paid to the survivors of individuals killed in the line of duty. It is assumed that the provisions of the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.
