- **IN RE: HB900** by Israel (Relating to the act of smoking tobacco in a vehicle with a child present; imposing a civil penalty.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that the provisions of the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

## Local Government Impact

The cost to bring a civil case would greatly exceed the \$15 civil fine. Therefore, there would be a fiscal impact from HB 900, as introduced, however, since it is not known how often these cases would occur. The extent of that impact cannot be estimated at this time.
