IN RE: HB1288 by Sanford (Relating to the carrying and possession of a handgun by a public junior college school marshal.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Education Code relating to the carrying and possession of a handgun by a public junior college school marshal. This analysis assumes that duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
