IN RE: HB1306 by Frullo (Relating to the provision of flood coverage under insurance policies issued by surplus lines insurers.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill would amend the Insurance Code relating to the provision of flood coverage under insurance policies issued by surplus lines insurers. Based on information provided by the Texas Department of Insurance, this analysis assumes that the duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.

The bill applies only to an insurance policy delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2020. The bill would take effect on September 1, 2019.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
