**IN RE:** **HB1374** by Hernandez (Relating to grants for the development and operation of pretrial intervention programs for pregnant defendants and defendants who are the primary caretaker of a child.), **As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Government Code to allow the Texas Department of Criminal Justice to award grants to certain entities for the development and operation of pretrial programs for defendants who are pregnant or are the primary caretaker of a child.
