IN RE: HB1443 by Thompson, Senfronia (Relating to the certification of an area's wet or dry status for the purpose of an alcoholic beverage permit or license.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Alcoholic Beverage Code to require certain local governmental officials to certify within thirty days certain information related to an area's wet or dry status for the purpose of alcoholic beverage permit or license. The Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission and the Comptroller indicate that the bill would not result in a significant fiscal impact to the State.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2019.

Local Government Impact

According to the Texas Association of Counties, no fiscal implication to counties is anticipated.
