**IN RE: HB1533** by Collier (Relating to a political subdivision's adoption of zoning regulations for certain coin-operated machines.), **As Introduced** 

## No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Occupations Code to authorize political subdivision to adopt zoning regulations to govern certain coin-operated machines. It repeals a requirement that this zoning follow the principal use of the property and that authorizes the prohibition of these machines in certain circumstances.

### **Local Government Impact**

According to the Texas Municipal League, the bill would not have a significant impact on cities.

According to the Texas Association of Counties, the bill would have no impact on counties.
