IN RE: HB1618 by Cyrier (relating to the provision of state death benefits to certain members of the Texas military forces.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would provide certain death benefits to survivors of members of the Texas military forces who die in the line of duty if they are not eligible to receive federal survivor benefits. While the occurrence and timing of these events are too difficult to predict, this analysis assumes that the provisions of the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
