IN RE: HB1641 by Button (Relating to the provision of information to certain women enrolled in the Healthy Texas Women program.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that the provisions of the bill relating to the provision of information to certain women enrolled in the Healthy Texas Women program could be absorbed using existing resources. The bill would take effect immediately upon receiving a two-thirds majority vote in each house. Otherwise, the bill would take effect September 1, 2019.
