**IN RE: HB1655** by Hunter (Relating to the availability of dates of birth under the public information law.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Government Code to specify that government bodies are not authorized to withhold a date of birth under the public information law except under certain circumstances.
